- 1. RSA New Support Website Project Updates -
 - 1.1 Since last meeting in the new support website project
 - o Improved slight navigation issues using feedback from the test sessions.
 - o Report compiled and many of the issues were addressed.

 - Cataloging content is still being organized. TBD when upload will begin.

1.2 What's next in the new support website project

- November December : Content load reaching into cataloging sections of the site.
 - Continue cleaning up theme, making it more uniform across the various page templates.
 - Once completed with these sections, conduct a brief 2nd round of user testing on cataloging pages. 3-5 testers max. Extra feedback to improve navigation and wayfinding in those areas.
- January : launch beside the current site.
 - Evaluate which pages (on current rsanfp.org) can have their content hidden and have traffic rerouted (manually, since I don't think Enterprise allows for auto-redirects.)
 - Domain chosen and registered. A suggestion was made to keep the domain the same as it is now. // rsanfp.org
 - Essentially, all existing links and bookmarks will continue to work.
- 2. Next meeting date? Recommendation that we postpone further meetings about the website.
