## Children of Multiple Households Procedure

## Last updated: February 9, 2024

Children who live in multiple households with different legal guardians are eligible to have a library card for each household, even if both legal guardians live in the same library service area.

To avoid confusion when registering a child for a card, please make sure that the responsible legal guardian of that particular household is listed in the C/O field.

The User Cards policy refers to "one card per patron." This is one of the approved exceptions of this rule.

Conceivably a child may then have 3 cards in the system due to a school-issued RSA student card.
