

## **Children of Multiple Households Procedure**

Children who live in multiple households with different legal guardians are eligible to have a library card for each household, even if both legal guardians live in the same library service area.

To avoid confusion when registering a child for a card, please make sure that the responsible legal guardian **of that particular household** is listed in the C/O field.



The <u>User Cards policy</u> refers to "one card per patron." This is one of the approved exceptions of this rule.

Conceivably a child may then have 3 cards in the system due to a school-issued RSA student card.
