Subject: Rebate from Reserves to RSA Members in FY25 – FY29

The RSA Board of Directors authorized a 5-year phase-in of the new RSA Fee Structures. During the phase-in period, excess expenses over income will be covered by a rebate offsetting total member library fees pulled from RSA reserve funds. Rebate amounts will be reduced each year through FY29. Over the next 5 years, RSA will assess approximately \$786,000 in rebates to members.
