What is an Open Access publication?

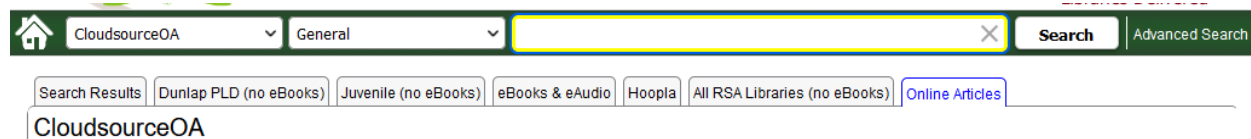
⇒ An Open Access publication is a scholarly journal article, eBook, eTextbook or Open Education Resource that is published through a funding model providing free full text access.

What type of content will I find in the CloudSourceOA database?

⇒ You will find high quality, peer-reviewed, academic publications covering a broad range of subject areas such as Health Sciences, Environment, Computer Science, Business and many more.

Where can I find it in the library catalog?

⇒ Any search in the catalog will automatically generate results from your CloudSourceOA database. Results can be found in the **Online Articles** tab of the results page.



Who is this material suitable for?

⇒ Anyone who needs high-quality, peer-reviewed articles!

Who has access ?

⇒ Full text publications are freely available on the catalog. Library users do not need to be members to access the content.

How do I get to the full text content?

⇒ Clicking on the **View Resource** button on the results page will open the publication in full text format on a new webpage.
