Introducing our Interactive Collection Browser! With this report, you can create shelflists on the fly, dynamically changing what you see in the report instantly, or close to it.

Just click the link to open the report directly, then enter your BCA login information and you will be dropped directly into the report.


There are some instructions at the top in the yellow box.

Instructions: Choose one or more a libraries the GREEN box. Refine the item listing by making selections in the 4 green/grey filters to limit the output of the report. A selection in any of the green/gray filters will change the options in the other 3 filters. The 7 light gray filters with dragbar sliders allow you to further refine the items show in the list. Title and Item counts for your selections appear to the left of this window. 1) You can export the item list by putting your mouse over the list. then clicking the small 3 dot pop-over in the upper right of the list. Then select the Export option and either Excel or PDF. Or click the


The red bounded box in the top left shows the title and item count based on your selected filters. You will need to change the Library selection from AG\_ALS-PDC to your library or libraries. Just click the library dropdown, unselect the AG\_ALS-PDS library, the check the box next to your library.




All the other filters, in gray boxes, adjust to show the counts, dates, or parameters of the library(s) selected in the green Library box. The smaller gray filters have sliders with both endpoints adjustable. As you slide them, you see the data, count, or date they are set to just above the slider. If it says (All) then they are set to return ALL of the data for that filter.



You can bookmark sets of filter selections, give them a name, then return to them directly via the ribbon icon in the upper left of the menu bar. These are remembered across sessions and should remain available until we make big modifications to the report. For those that use the tool to monitor things that will be a HUGE help.
