



Reshelving Location Cheat Sheet

Last updated: December 16, 2024

The Reshelving location is a location which is assigned to recently discharged materials. No additional action is needed to move items into this location. Items will automatically return to the correct home location at the end of the reshelving period.

Items remain in this location for 6 hours after discharge. During this time, items in Reshelving will display a status of “Being returned to standard shelving location” in RSACat and a location of Reshelving in Workflows.
