	<b>OVERDRIVE</b> is the VENDOR that manages the lending platform/technology and works with publishers to lease access to titles for libraries
	<b>LIBBY</b> is the APP from Overdrive on which their library customers' collections (such as ADML) are made available to library patrons.
	<b>ADML</b> is the SHARED COLLECTION specific to the participating central Illinois libraries that pool their funds to create it.

### BORROWING BASICS

- 14 days is the default lending period. Patrons can select 7 or 21 days at checkout or change their default.
- 5 is the number of checkouts and holds allowed at one time. No monthly limit (like hoopla)
- Renewals are allowed starting 3 days before the due date as long as no patrons have the title on hold.

### LENDING MODELS

A lending model is the purchasing and borrowing terms for digital content, determined by the Publisher. Many titles in the Overdrive catalog are available in multiple lending models at different prices. The lending model determines the length of TIME the title will be available in the collection.

## BUDGET

The ADML Collection is managed by a selection committee.

## MEMBER FEES

- Annual membership of \$0.15pp (IPLAR Service population) with \$500 minimum (+25 for non-RSA libraries)
- Circulation fee of \$0.05 per annual ADML circulation of 1,000+ which is billed in January and used to fill holds and lower wait times.
- \$500 credit to Advantage Plus libraries who share Advantage titles into the shared collection

## ADVANTAGE

- Allows libraries in ADML to offer additional titles and fill requests for exclusive use by your cardholders
- Libraries can reduce wait times by adding extra copies of popular titles for their cardholders.
- A library's advantage titles and shared collection titles appear to their logged in patrons together in the Libby App.

## ADVANTAGE PLUS

- Allows Advantage libraries to expand access to their Advantage titles to other ADML libraries
- A Shared title still belongs to the Advantage library and its cardholders have priority for holds, though shared titles can be borrowed by any ADML patron.
