




RSA Directors Day Survey Results

For question 1, most of the Maybes were related to date and location.


3. Rank these options in order of preference by dragging them

- I feel like smaller libraries lack the guidance of having to wear all the hats that go with the director position. So someone who can speak on that?


- Alex Todd? Beth Duttlinger? Any director who is well seasoned and knows things?

- I like the idea but would not be able to miss other RSA all staff sessions to attend. Many of the topics are covered with listservs and local directors groups.


- Please don't hold this event in the midst of the summer programming season!
